



**Psalm-Writing** for Healing A way for our hearts to express anger and grief, but in the face of faith and hope. A productive response to the iniustice in this world



**F**irst Samuel begins the transition of Israel from a disjointed nation ruled by many individual judges to a monarchy. Israel needed a leader to unite them and refocus their attention to being God's people. Samuel was able to make this happen in his life through ultimately appointing David to be King. The monarchy brought new vision and unity to the people of Israel. Samuel is said to be the most instrumental leader of Israel between Moses and David. He was an important influence during a transitional part of Israel's history. But before Samuel, was his mother Hannah who waited for him, just as Israel was waiting for a new king.

#### Read I Samuel 1:1-20.

1. The Bible often highlights the mothers of great leaders. These faithful women listened to and trusted God's plan. Reflect on some of those women:

**Jochebed**, the mother of Moses, who saved him by putting him in the river and then helping to raise him;

Hannah, the mother of Samuel;

Mary, the mother of Jesus.

Are there others that come to mind? How did these women model faithfulness and trust in God?

- 2. Life was not going as planned for Hannah. How did she respond to a reality that was not the one she wanted? How have you responded when life has taken turns you did not expect? Where do you see the character of Hannah in this story and the character of God?
- 3. Hannah's prayer to God for a baby also involved a promise that she would return him to God. Read 1 Samuel 1:10-11. She said that he would be set apart to serve God. From the beginning that was her plan. What is our responsibility to nurture and guide the children under our influence to prepare them for a life of devotion to God?
- 4. St. Augustine said that "Faith is to believe what you do not see; the reward of this faith is to see what you believe." Hannah prayed in anguish, but even through her grief she displayed her faith in God. Where have you seen God's faithfulness? Where is he asking you to trust when life isn't going as planned?
