

SERMON NOTES



This is the final in our four-part kickoff sermon series on Acts <u>chapter 2</u> and <u>chapter 8</u>. In Acts 2, we looked at how when the first disciples were "all together," the Holy Spirit came in power to make them witnesses to all people, the Apostle Peter stood and preached Good News to all those gathered from every nation and tongue, and then a diverse and devoted community was formed. They *gathered* and grew, cared and shared, and then *scattered* beyond Jerusalem to share the Gospel—"in Samaria and to the ends of the earth." Where the Apostle Peter in Acts 2 preached to thousands, Philip in Acts 8 witnesses to one seeker of God from Ethiopia.
