What kinds of things bewitch people and put them under a spell? Paul lived the first half of his life under the spell of religious legalism—circumcision, sabbath and the Mosaic Law.

After his encounter with Jesus, Paul wrote,

...the very commandment that promised life proved to be death to me.

(Romans 7:10)

Jesus broke Paul's spell of religious legalism and replaced it with grace and love.

Paul began planting churches around the core reality of Jesus' love and grace.

Word came that the churches in Galatia had reverted to religious legalism. Why is religious legalism so attractive? So, Paul wrote these words,

O you foolish Galatians. Who has bewitched you?

Jesus' love is the great spell-breaker.

SPELL #1 – Life is hopeless

• What makes hope difficult?

SPELL #2 - Life is meaningless

• Where do you find meaning in life?

SPELL #3 -I am worthless

• What kinds of things happen when people feel worthless?

SPELL #4 - Love has its limits

• Where do you tend to underestimate the power of love?
