

# MDPC Kids - Preschool Ministries

## Bible Verses

Suggested activities to assist preschool children in memorizing Scripture:

1. Act out the Bible verse
2. Draw a picture (this works well with the fruit of the Spirit in Galatians).
3. When they begin writing, write out the verse in chalk on the sidewalk or on paper or on a window with special glass crayons.
4. Sing the verse.
5. Say the verse to one another while playing catch or hopping on one foot, *etc.*
6. Select Scripture to memorize that is applicable to something the child is experiencing at the time (fear, disobedience, *etc.*)
7. Purchase a spiral bound ring of notecards and write (or type up and print out stickers) a verse on each card. Or, write the verses on large sticky notes and put them on the bathroom mirror to review while brushing teeth. This helps the child learn to read and review the verses they have and are currently learning.

## Old Testament

- In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. – **Genesis 1:1**
- The LORD is my shepherd. I have everything I need. – **Psalms 23:1**
- Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good! His faithful love endures forever. – **Psalms 118:1**

- Blessed are those who trust in the LORD and have made the LORD their hope and confidence. – **Jeremiah 17:7**

- Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex! Your workmanship is marvelous – how well I know it. – **Psalm 139:14**
- For the LORD your God is living among you. He is a mighty savior. He will take delight in you with gladness. With his love, he will calm all your fears. He will rejoice over you with joyful songs. – **Zephaniah 3:17**

## New Testament

- For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life. – **John 3:16**
- For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. – **Romans 3:23**
- Christ died for us while we were still sinners. In this way God shows his great love for us. – **Romans 5:8**
- Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the LORD. – **Colossians 3:20**

- The man answered, “You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your strength, and all your mind.” And, “Love your neighbor as yourself.” – **Luke 10:27**
- ...“I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.” – **John 14:6**
- So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. – **John 13:34**

- And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns. – **Philippians 1:6**
- Devote yourselves to prayer with an alert mind and a thankful heart. – **Colossians 4:2**
- For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline. - **2 Timothy 1:7**
- So whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God. – **1 Corinthians 10:31**
- Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them. – **Ephesians 4:29**
- ...be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you. – **Ephesians 4:32**
- Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. – **Philippians 4:6**

- But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things! – **Galatians 5:22-23**
- Always be joyful. Never stop praying. Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God’s will for you who belong to Christ Jesus. - **I Thessalonians 5:16-18**
- And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him. – **Colossians 3:17**

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. – **Philippians 4:13**
