This is the third of four in our series covering the defining junctures in the Good News Story. If you had to summarize the Gospel, Genesis through Revelation, what would you highlight? We already have covered our Creation and *The Fall*, and then *The Law*. Today we look more closely at Jesus, *The Christ*.

- 1. Mining your memory, when was the first time you remember hearing about Jesus? Was it a positive memory and association or a negative one? Who shared it? Where? When?
- 2. Having listened to the first two sermons in this series, how do the Fall and the three uses of the Law point us in the end to our need for a Savior? What would the world be like, in your opinion, if Jesus had not come approximately two thousand years ago? What would we not know and have access to that we *do* know and benefit from because of the Messiah coming?
- 3. In my sermon, I shared a couple of illustrations from Sebastian Junger's book, *Tribe: On Homecoming and Belonging* relating to the European colonists' encounters with the Native Americans, as well as recent studies concerning post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD). What do they reveal about our need for connection and community? But how does our rugged individualism and sin prevent or complicate our ability to find deep friendships and meaningful immediate and spiritual families?
- 4. I shared a psychological concept called *attachment theory* using wooden blocks. What insights about your life and ways you function or display dysfunction resulted from your wrestling with those concepts?
- 5. Read <u>Matthew 3:13-17</u>. I said to the baptism families on Sunday that "we know Jesus ended His ministry between two thieves on a cross to save us from our sins; but maybe we forget Jesus began His ministry in a river surrounded by sinners." If Jesus was sinless, why was He baptized amongst sinners? And how do the words from the Voice of Heaven to Jesus also apply to us?
- 6. Finally, how and why do the words from the Voice of Heaven *to you* make all the difference in the world? How might you replace some of your broken foundational blocks with those affirmations from God, those promises of Scripture? And how will you through MDPC practice safely removing masks and armor so relational intimacy and community can flower in your life?
