Sunday, Feb 27, 2022 • Rev. Dr. Alf Halvorson Serving Like the Savior • Philippians 2:4-11

This is a stand-alone message for our *Church in the City* Weekend. We are not worshipping exclusively in our Sanctuary this weekend, but also out in our community, neighborhoods, with ministry partners, and even in our wider church building. Colossians 3:17 says, "Whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him." Our work can be worship when it is offered as a prayer to God.

- 1. Have you done a project for Church in the City in the past? What was it? Where was it hard? And where did it feed you or give you life? What component did community or teamwork play in the accomplishment of the task and goal?
- 2. Read <u>Philippians 2:4-11</u>. If the thesis for this section of scripture is vs. 4, then how is the example of Christ in verses 5-8 worthy of our consideration and imitation?
- 3. In verses 9-11, we see how God the Father rewards and exalts God the Son. If Jesus' actions in verses 5-8 produce that kind of result in the Father's heart and commendation, why don't we see service and sacrifice in a more positive light?
- 4. In my shortened message, I talked about a couple of Greek words and how they reveal God's Character and Will and Ways. How do you believe we should interpret verse 6 and 7 as a result of my teaching?
- 5. If God's way is to give and empty and love and serve, how might we nurture these God-given impulses and Christ's example? In other words, what Spiritual Disciplines might you take on so that Christ's character might be formed in you in this way? Or how might we be more and more conformed to Christ's way of *emptying*?
- 6. Church in the City is a great weekend of working together. How might this one weekend spur other attitudes and actions during some or more or many of the other weeks of the year? How can we help you find your niche, based on your gifts and interests and time available? Note: Every pastor, director, staff member, or lay leader at MDPC would love to talk to you about this matching process. Reach out to someone you know and respect, if and where you need help connecting. You won't regret it!


