# **SERMON**NOTES

The Books of Ezra & Nehemiah

### Trusting in God's Protection

Ezra 7:1-10 NRSV

This is the fourth in our fall sermon series on Ezra & Nehemiah. We have baptisms and an Alpha Focus this Sunday, and the sermon series shifts to the time when Ezra, the name of the first book we are studying, makes his way onto the stage. He will be the dominant leader the rest of the book, and at times in the book of Nehemiah as well.

- 1. If people were to sum up your life in a sentence or two, what would you wish they would say about you? What would you not want said about you?
- 2. Ezra chapters 7-10 deal with the leader, Ezra, establishing the Worship & Word rhythm for the people of God in the years after the Second Temple was completed and dedicated. If you have the time, read chapters 7 and 8 in one sitting. What do you learn about Ezra's leadership style as well as what is important to him? What does he accomplish, with the help of God and others?
- 3. Specifically in verses 1-6 of chapter 7, what do you learn about Ezra? Do you recognize any of the names from the first five verses? Using a Bible dictionary or commentary, what is significant about Ezra's lineage?
- 4. He is a priest (like the chief priest, Aaron, vs. 5) but also a scribe (vss. 6 and 10). What are positives about that combination?
- 5. In verses 7-9 of chapter 7, who else joined Ezra on the trip? Are any groups significant, in your mind? And how long did it take them to make the trip from Babylon to Jerusalem? What might it have been like if you had been part of the pilgrimage?
- 6. Verse 10 is an incredibly packed and significant sentence. Remember back to question 1 on this Sermon Notes page. How does verse 10 sum up Ezra's life and ministry? What are the three components of what Ezra "set his mind to" or "devoted himself" to do here?
- 7. Why or why not would it be worthwhile for you to undergo a similar pursuit? What would it take in scheduling and commitment for you to become more like Ezra in verse 10? What from my sermon possibly gave you some handles or approaches to explore this fall as an individual, family, or friend grouping?
