# DIGGING DEEPER



This is the sixth and final message in our *Jesus Talks* series from the Gospel of John. We get to overhear what Jesus says to His Father in prayer. This is the "other" Lord's Prayer. It's kind of like a congregation during a pastoral prayer: not directly addressed, but very much in the mind of the one praying. Jesus prays about His own needs shortly before His crucifixion; He intercedes for His initial disciples, and then He prays for us specifically.

Jesus anticipates you and me. You and I are being prayed for *by Christ* right here in the Gospel. To hear your name spoken in a prayer is a humbling and moving experience.

- 1. In John 17:1-5, Jesus prays to be faithful in the last few days of His life. What specifically does He ask for here?
- 2. How would you define "glorify"? In other words, what does it mean to glorify the Son and glorify the Father? Is the word "glory" used the same in the world and in the words of Jesus?
- 3. In John 17:6-19, Jesus prays for the original disciples. What does Jesus ask for here? Does what He asks for surprise you, or does it confirm some things for you? Is there anything highlighted that you would not highlight? Is there anything ignored that you think should have been included?
- 4. In John 17:20-26, Jesus prays for future believers, including us. What is asked for here?
- 5. According to Jesus (verses 21, 23), what will help the world believe that God sent Jesus?
- 6. From the text, what constitutes our oneness? Is it our faithfulness? Do we manufacture it? Is it in Christ? Where does the Word come in regarding oneness? See verses 8, 14, 17, 19, and 20.
- 7. Verse 18 has been an important part of MDPC's ethos from the beginning. Christ is sent (apostled by God) to the world; we are apostled (sent) into the world as well. Have you applied this text yet personally in your life? Share stories...
- 8. Where are we scared to live out Jesus' prayer for us? How does verse 26 give us courage and hope?
