Christmas Greetings!

Merry Christmas, friends! Welcome to Christmas Eve services at MDPC. Revelation 5:6-14 reveals a future time when people of all nations will bow before Jesus and say, "Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive...honor and glory and blessing...forever and ever." This verse reminded me that on several of the trips I've been blessed to take to Israel, our group visited Bethlehem. A plain but beautiful church marks the recognized birthplace of Jesus. Behind the altar in the church is a cave, lit by lamps.

There is a star embedded in the floor of the cave to recognize

the birth of the King. However, to see the inside of the church as well as the cave, there is a hurdle to overcome. The door to the church is so low, you can't go in standing up. You have to crouch down to enter. Our guide said that when the church was built, the door was constructed this way to prevent vandals from riding in on horses and desecrating this holy place.

I took a more spiritual explanation away from our visit to the site. As we approach Christmas and the celebration of the birth of our Savior and Lord, we can only get a close look, we can only witness God in human flesh, we can only worship Him as Lord when we symbolically get down on our knees. Why wait for some future date? Why not crouch low now? "O Come let us adore Him, Christ the Lord."


