You may want to either drop your gift in the offering plate on Sunday, December 30, or bring it by the church office by Monday, December 31. The most convenient option is to give online at **give.mdpc.org**.

If you plan to make gifts from your IRA or Donor Advised fund, please request those soon to insure they are dated before the end of the year to be posted to 2018 giving.
