- Pray for peace in Ukraine and the opportunity to develop as a nation that values truth, justice, and freedom, all rooted in the goodness of God.
- Pray for wisdom among our world's leaders as they seek a resolution to end the war.
- Pray for the people of Ukraine that are grieving, fearful, confused, angry, and in shock. Pray for peace, comfort, healing, and hope.
- Pray for safety, strength, and peace for families that have been separated.

- Pray for the provision of food, medicine, and basic necessities for those who remain in Ukraine, as well as those who have left everything behind to flee for safety.
- Pray for wisdom, direction, and protection of our partners who are serving inside Ukraine or are serving refugees in neighboring countries. Pray that God would give them strength and multiply their resources.
- Pray for the Church to remain united and that it would be a beacon of light in this dark time.
- Pray for Christians in Ukraine. Ask God to equip them to respond to those who are suffering, give the comfort of Christ, and to remain faithful in their witness.
- Pray that God would use this crisis to draw many people to Himself. May the people of Ukraine and Russia discover that Jesus is the only true source of peace, safety, comfort, truth and freedom.
