

# ***Jesus Raises Lazarus From the Dead***

- ✧ *to show Himself as Lord of life and death just before He should be Himself condemned to die;*
- ✧ *to strengthen the faith of His disciples;*
- ✧ *to convert many Jews;*
- ✧ *to cause the priests to hasten their movements so as to be ready when His hour had come.*

*“You know nothing at all! You do not realize that it is better for you that one man die for the people than the whole nation perish.”*

*John 11:49-53*

*If the experience of Lazarus is a picture of what happens to a person when he/she trusts Christ and is given new life, what might the grave clothes in verse 44 represent in your life? Where might Jesus be asking you to “take off the grave clothes and let him/her go”?*
